What is the Pathfinder project?

- The Pathfinder project is run by Northamptonshire County Council and works to facilitate community-led improvements in resilience and preparedness for communities which are at risk of surface water flooding in Northamptonshire.
- The scheme is funded by the Anglian Northern Regional Flood and Coastal Committee.



How can the project help your community?

Each participating community receives:

- A visual survey of the catchment area
- A Community Flood Risk and Mitigation Investigation undertaken by civil engineers
- Training of appointed flood wardens
- Support in the development of a Community Emergency and Flood Plan
- Limited grant funding for products/services/works which benefit flood risk management and help to improve resilience
