The Cemetery, Station Road

The Council has now taken over ownership of the Cemetery from Wellingborough Borough Council and has started planning for urgent remedial works such as some tree work, painting and repairing the exteriors of the chapels and pathway work. Pocket Park

Wellingborough Borough Council has now also transferred ownership of the Pocket Park to Finedon. A survey will be taking place of the park so that a programme of remedial works can be put in place. If you have noticed any areas that need attention in the park, please let the Clerk know so that they can be assessed.

Library

It is understood that the Library will not be re-opening until January 2021, as agreed with Northamptonshire Library Service.

Highways

The grant funding obtained has allowed the Council to purchase 2 new vehicle activated signs which have been ordered. They are able to provide useful data to the Council with regards to traffic as well as speeding. A recent survey on Irthlingborough Road has meant that the Safer Roads Team will be setting up speed cameras on a monthly basis.
