Community Litter Pick

The Community Litter Pick which was scheduled to take place on Saturday 19 September 2020 unfortunately had to be postponed. However, the Council hope to be able to rearrange this event for the near future – ensuring all Covid-19 rules and social distancing are followed.

The Cemetery, Station Road

The Council is still looking to bring the Chapels back into use, many site visits have been conducted and enquiries have begun to explore the possibilities of obtaining electric/sewage facilities. However, further progression of this project will be based upon the costs and whether the Council are able to obtain any funding.

Banks Park

There was damage caused to the fence/hedge of the Play Area by an unknown vehicle, the Council have arranged the repair which will be completed in due course.

The Council are in the process of purchasing a Christmas tree to be put up in Banks Park, which will hopefully provide some Christmas spirit to the town.

Highways

The Council now has in their possession 2 new vehicle activated signs (VAS) which will be placed on rotation around Finedon to reduce the issue of speeding. The signs will be placed in strategic locations, hopefully very shortly, once the relevant training has been provided.
