

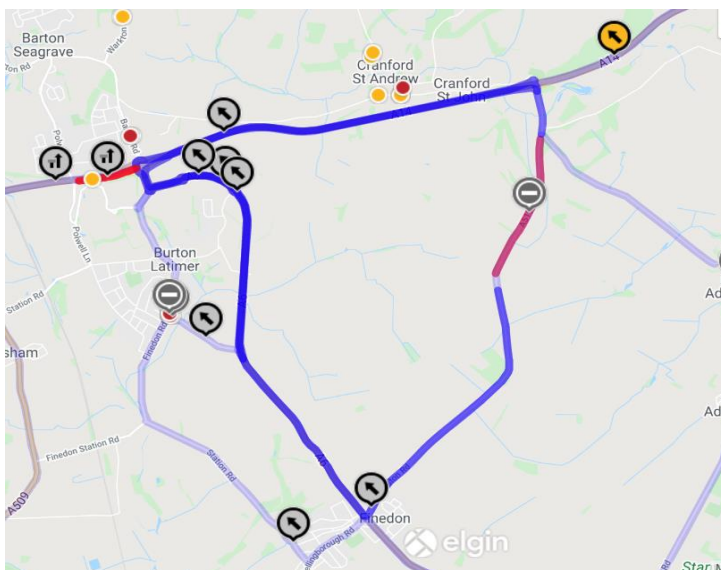
**Start date** – Friday 11 December

**Completion** – Saturday 19 December (Weather dependent)

**Scheme type** – Patching and resurfacing works

**Traffic management** – Weekend full road closure and night closures with diversion

**Hours of work** – varies- shown below



**What we are doing/the benefits** – Northamptonshire Highways are scheduled to carry out carriageway improvement works on the A510 out of Finedon to Cranford St John. Carriageway resurfacing and patching will be completed at locations along the road. In addition to these works, we will be replacing the road marking, cleaning the gullies, and carrying out any associated works. When complete, this will improve the road surface and extend the life of this road.

#### **COVID-19 message from Northamptonshire County Council.**

Our Government identified key workers are carrying out essential highway works for us, whilst maintaining social distancing and following all COVID-19 guidelines to ensure the health and safety of our workforce and residents.

Northamptonshire Highways, its contractors and suppliers are identified as key workers as defined by the government: ***“those who will keep the air, water, road and rail passenger and freight transport modes operating during the Covid-19 response including those in supply chains”***, and that these works have been defined as essential works by the government.

Our priority is to keep the highway network open and safe. We are also working to keep on programme with highway works to improve communities and repair roads

We would like to assure you that all of our site teams have been extensively briefed on all Government Guidance regarding social distancing, increased cleanliness, and working within communities. The Government has also permitted that workers, where necessary, may be in groups of more than two to undertake works and that, whilst the 2-meter physical distancing rule should always try and be achieved, this would not always be practicable.

To eliminate the need to knock on doors and help us with our work, please could you move any vehicles parked within this section of the road. Thank you for your understanding, patience, and co-operation.

#### **Information for residents**

**Access:** The road closure will be in place for the duration of the work, and vehicle access to your property will be affected during the works. We will do all we can to maintain access and have planned the work in stages to help with this.

Residents will be asked to use an alternative route to access and to leave their properties. Please allow extra time for your journey. Our team will be on site to help. An intercom system will be in place near all property entrances that fall within the closed section of road. Please use this system should you need to exit your property onto the highway network. This will alert the team and help will be provided to ensure the safety of you and the workforce.

**Businesses:** We have planned this work at night and over one weekend to minimise disruption. If you have any concerns please get in touch with us.

**Cyclists:** Cyclists will be affected during the work. Cyclist will need to dismount and walk on the footway to access the residential area. Cyclists will not be able access A510 between junction of Eastlands Road and A14 junction 11.

**Pedestrians:** Pedestrians are not affected during the works.

#### **Traffic Management**

When programming works, we consider the impact on all network users and plan our works to minimise disruption as much as possible. Please see below for phasing:

**Friday 11 December** – Road closure starts 20.00 and the A510 will be closed continuously over the weekend until Sunday 13 at 22.00. We will limit our planned night works to the area by the Wind Farm on the A510 but we will need to close the entire road. During daytime working hours we will attempt to complete all patching required within the residential area of Finedon and complete the surfacing works by the Wind Farm.

**Monday 14 to Friday 18 December only** – Overnight road closures each night for the week 20.00 – 06.00. This work will mainly be taking place on the A510 leading away from the roundabout in Finedon. As mentioned above our intention is to complete works within the residential area during day time working.

During the road closure a vehicle diversion route, (as shown in blue), will be in place at all times. Refer to [one.network](#)
