The Cemetery, Station Road

At present, the Council is currently in the process of having work completed to the exterior woodwork by a painter and decorator. There is a large amount of rotten wood which has been identified, the old Clerk and RFO had obtained quotes for this work, but upon further inspection more works is required than initially anticipated. Therefore, further quotes will be obtained to ensure the correct work is carried out as required.
