Elections

Library Lease

Due to the current pandemic the Library is unable to open and the Council will be deciding when the lease should commence. However, such decision was postponed until further information was obtained in relation to the consequences of the change of Unitary councils.

(Borough Council of Wellingborough will cease to exist as a sovereign entity on 31 March 2021 and the new North Northamptonshire Unitary Council will take effect from 1 April 2021.)

War Memorial and Green

The War Memorial and Green are currently in the process of being registered to Finedon Town Council. However there is a backlog at the Land Registry, which is causing a delay in us obtaining ownership.

Banks Park

In accordance with lockdown restrictions, the playground can remain open but Tennis Courts cannot.
