Grant

The Council is pleased to confirm they have been awarded a £5,000 grant from North Northamptonshire Council to put towards their clearance project in Tainty Field.

The Clearance Project started back in 2022 with the aims of tidying overgrown areas, so they can be utilised by members of the public. The Council would like to re-establish the community orchard, by planting more fruit trees and installing a natural hogging path with robust benches for users of the park to take a seat and enjoy the surroundings.

We hope to have this project finished by the end of the year and hope it can be enjoyed by all residents of Finedon.

The Council had been approached by The Wildlife Trust to take over ownership of Cally Banks.
